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Assembling & Assembly Point

- When assembling festival floats of others, participating organisations may only nail or screw items to any wooden areas of the vehicle platform. Nails/screws must not be used on any metal or painted areas of the vehicle, including all external painted surfaces. Items may also be suspended from the internal structure of the vehicle. Sticky tape (including double-sided tape) may be used internally, but must not, under any circumstances, be applied to the external vehicle paintwork.
- When assembling at Hitachi ABB Power Grids (HAPG), Oulton Road, Stone, ST15 0RS, the ONLY vehicles that will be permitted to park will be those which have previously had consent, all other vehicles will be given 5 minutes to drop off and leave. Please ensure that Parents/Guardians are aware of these time limits as they are necessary for the smooth running of the day for everyone. If you require a vehicle to stay at HAPG please inform one of the Tabarded Stone Festival Team ASAP.
- For safety reasons, passengers should not travel from the float assembly point to HAPG, on the back of the vehicle - they should meet the vehicle there.

Travelling in the Parade

- Organisers should ensure that Headlights, Flashing Beacons and Hazard Warning Lights are not obscured by float decorations as these will be required to be visible and active during the parade.
- All floats (open sided vehicles carrying young people, below 18 years of age) must have dedicated Wheel 5 Stewards for every moving wheel on the vehicle. The Wheel Stewards must travel with the wheel along the whole route from HAPG to Westbridge Park. Wheel Stewards must be at least 18 years of age. We reserve the right to refuse entry into the Parade if the appropriate number of Wheel Stewards are not present.
- Personal or Charity collections are strictly prohibited and require a Street Collection Permit. Collections made should be with a Stone Festival collection bucket and handed back into the designated point at Westbridge Park immediately after the Parade finishes.
- As a main priority Schools/Clubs must ensure that the appropriate adult to child ratio is upheld. The Stone Festival Committee recommend a 1:8 ratio and reserve the right to refuse entry if it is felt that a suitable number of adults are not present.

Other Information

- 8 Adults without wristbands at Westbridge Park will **NOT** be allowed onto the site free of charge - normal admission rates will apply.
- Parents should pick up their Children from the designated pick up site, which is outside the new Guide 9 Hut at the back of Westbridge Park. Please inform your Parents/Guardians of these arrangements.
- The Stone Festival Committee tries to ensure that all of the Parade is safe for all participants however this isn't always possible and things out of our control can happen. We suggest that you ensure that all your participants are properly protected with insurance and also sensible clothing and precautions including Sun Screen, Plenty of Water and a Hat/Cap.
- At any point the Stone Festival Committee reserve the right to change/amend the route of the Parade, and the start and end point(s) from the present one(s).
