

**STAFFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847**  
**STONE FESTIVAL**  
**SATURDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2019**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Borough Council of Stafford on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 2019 made an Order under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

1. That between the hours of 1.15 pm and 2.45 pm on Saturday the Eighth day of June Two Thousand and Nineteen no persons shall drive or ride any motor vehicle, horse, cart, carriage, bicycle or any other unauthorised vehicle of any description whatsoever along Oulton Road (from Lotus Court to the intersections with Old Road and Longton Road), Radford Street, Christchurch Way, Stafford Street and Stafford Road, (as far as the entrance to Westbridge Park), Stone all of which streets are situated within the said Borough PROVIDED ALWAYS that this prohibition shall not apply to the driver of any vehicle directed by a Police Officer in uniform to proceed through the said streets or any one of them.
2. Alternative routes to North Stone via Newcastle Road accessed off the A34 and alternative routes to South Stone via Lichfield Road accessed off the A51.
3. Every wilful breach of this Order shall be deemed a separate offence against the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and any person committing any such offence is liable to a penalty not exceeding £1000.
